- Give your spouse and yourself the gift of a Worldwide Marriage Encounter Weekend.



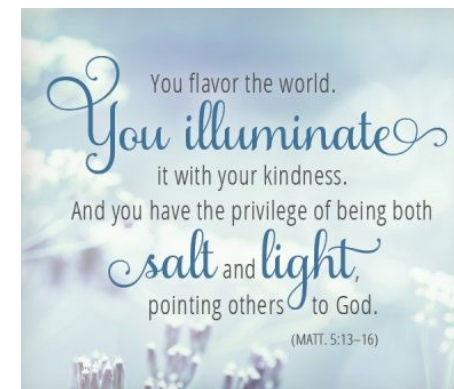

My name is Patrick (Pat) Edwards. I am an
ordained Deacon in the Catholic Church based in
the Glenelg parish. I have retired from active
duties and the major reason for this is that due to
strakes in both eyes my vision has deteriorated
rapidly over the past two years to the point where
I am now legally blind. During this time I was
desperate to locate a person or group who could
provide support to me especially for my spiritual
needs. I have found wonderful support for my
physical, mental and emotional issues, but not so
in the area of spirituality, especially in an
environment which understands vision loss.

I will be supported by a sighted person,
parishioner, Peter Sandercock and together we
aim to provide a welcoming and understanding
and nonthreatening support group. No doubt the
ministry will evolve, but we would hope to initially
have monthly meetings which would include
prayer, scriptural reflection and the opportunity to
share our lives with one another.
